Application Guidelines for Exchange Students to Ochanomizu University (Fiscal Year 2026)

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C. Admission

Student Status	<p>(a) Exchange Student: A status available for both undergraduate and graduate students who wish to earn credits. Students are required to register at least 8 classes per week including Japanese language classes.</p> <p>(b) Exchange Research Student: A status available only for graduate students who wish to conduct research under the guidance of an academic advisor. Students can audit some classes with prior approval from class lecturers but they cannot earn credits.</p>

Application Requirement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants should be female or women-identified students only. *For those whose gender identity differs from the record on their family register or passport, we can provide information and guidance, such as regarding the use of rooms, to help the student after the semester begins in advance. Please contact us for further details. • GPA: Applicants are recommended to have the latest GPA score of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale. However, students with a GPA below 2.5 may also be considered on a case by case basis. If this is the case, please consult before submitting the application. If the 4.0 scale doesn't apply to the grading system at their home university, please convert it to the 4.0 scale. • Language Proficiency: Applicants are expected to have the Japanese language proficiency necessary to participate in lectures, seminars and tutorials at Ochanomizu University. Those who choose the status "(b) Exchange Research Student" are not required to be proficient in Japanese if they have the English language proficiency necessary to conduct their research with approval from their academic advisor. • Exchange students should return and graduate from their home university after their period of study/research at Ochanomizu University.

Selection and Notification	<p>The result of selection will be notified to the partner university in around two months after each application deadline.</p>

D. Curriculum

Language of Instruction Japanese

Credit System Based on a credit unit system

Grading System Academic achievements are evaluated by S, A, B, C or D grades although S is applicable only to the Undergraduate Courses not to the Graduate Courses. Grade of "S" is given for excellent performance, "A" for good performance, "B" is for above average, "C" for average and "D" for failure.

Language Classes (Open to Exchange Students) The Japanese language classes are optional. There are two classes, "Seminar: Japanese" and "Seminar: Japanese Culture", each of which corresponds to 2 credits and is offered at 5 different levels from beginning to advance.

There are also Tokusetsu Nihongo (literally translated as "Special Japanese") classes ranging from "beginner level" to "advanced" level, such as "Conversation", "Writing", "Chinese Character", "Grammar", "Reading", and "Japanese Language Proficiency Test". These classes are not regular courses. Students who wish to transfer credits should contact their own universities in advance.

Students will be advised to take classes based on the result of a placement test required to take after application.
